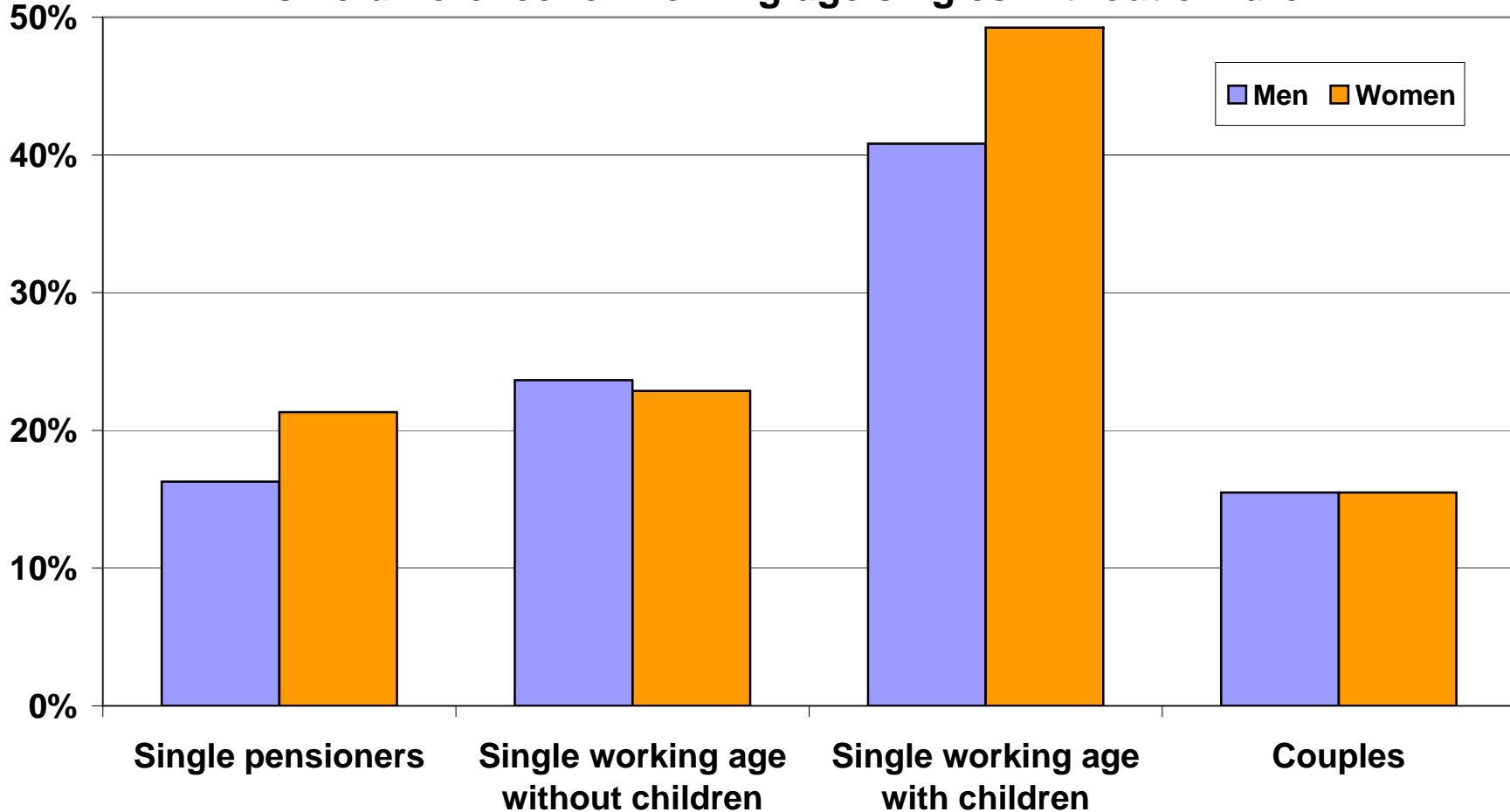


Single female pensioners and female lone parents are both more likely to be in low income households than their male equivalents, but there is no difference for working-age singles without children
