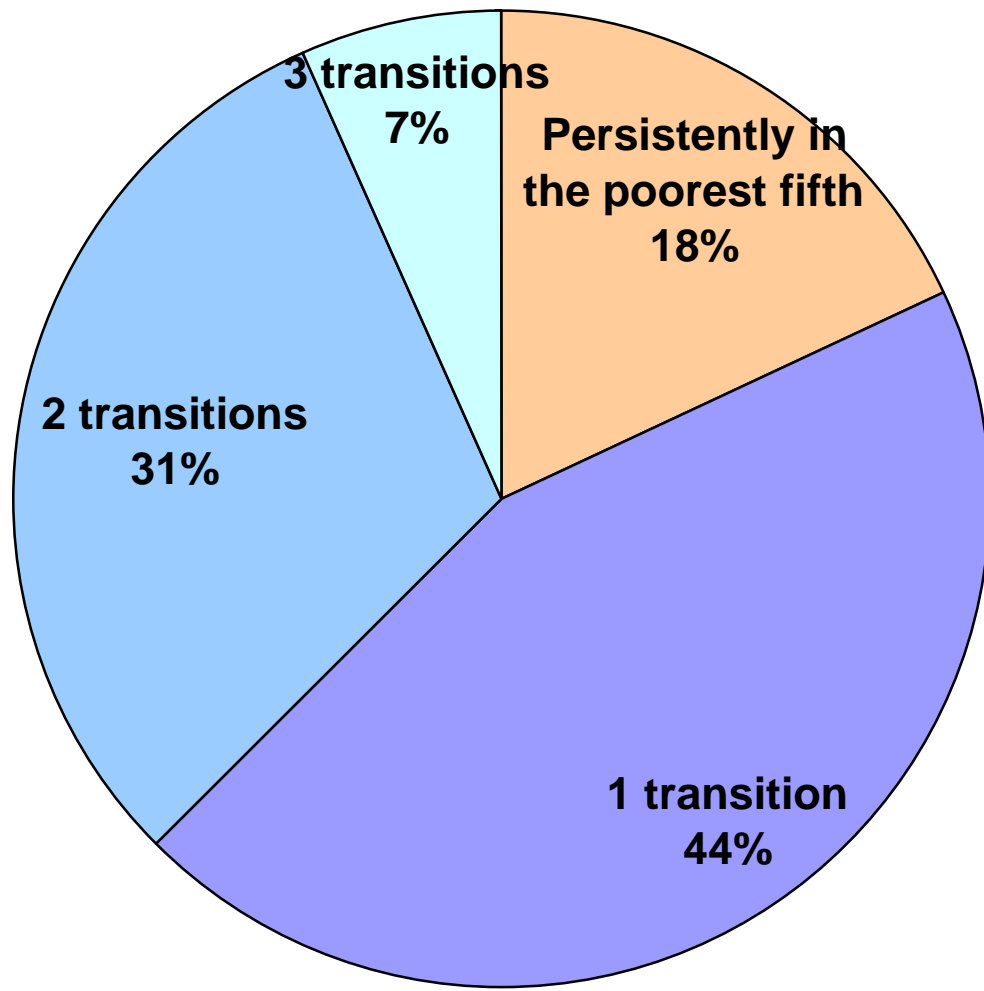


Most households who spend some time in low income move in and out of low income, with only a minority being persistently in low income
