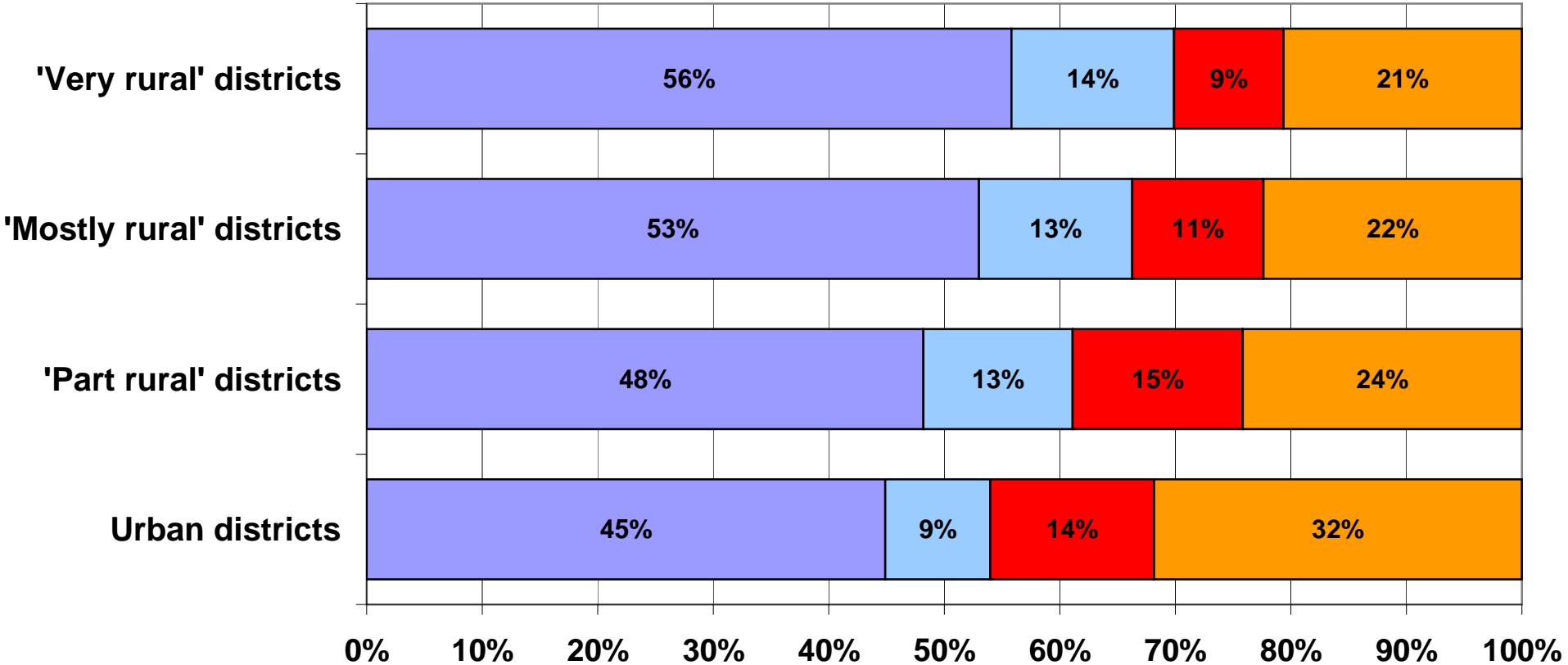


Two-thirds of children in low-income households in the more rural districts live in a family where at least one of the parents is working. This is a much higher proportion than that in urban districts.
